Also, one DBVI staff person has started their O&M education, and another interested person has contacted them about starting their educational journey, which is good for a long-term solution.  BEP⁴: Good news. Hired a new manager from Mississippi for Cross Café site. Currently Cross Café has micro market services, and in December they will open fully.
