Director's Report	Data Reporting: It was discovered that PRE-ETS³ data was being significantly under reported with the RSA⁴ Dashboard. With the work of Jessica Cavanaugh, staff, and including data from O&M instructors, the following increases are being reflected:  Quarter 2: 24 students with disabilities, 13% received pre-ets, with two instances of DBVI staff providing those services.  Quarter 3: 27 students with disabilities, 48% received pre-ets, with twenty instances of DBVI staff providing these services.  Budget Requests: DBVI submitted two Legislative budget requests which were approved. This included \$200,000 for assistive technology devices, services for the IL⁵ program, and 3 Assistive Technology positions for VR.	NONE	NONE
